As part of UC's **Research2030** investments in infrastructure and growing our research impact, we seek to support and enhance our research community whose activities *are aligned with ASTRO*. The goal of this funding support mechanism is to enable investigators to use <a href="the UC Advanced Research">the UC Advanced Research</a>
<a href="Computing Center">Computing Center</a> (ARCC) to obtain critical data for submission of a competitive extramural proposal, patent application, commercialization agreement, or peer-reviewed manuscript.
