The goal of this funding support mechanism is to enable investigators to use [the UC Advanced Research Computing Center](#) (ARCC) to obtain critical data for submission of a competitive extramural proposal, patent application, commercialization agreement, or peer-reviewed manuscript.

Successful applications will demonstrate: (a) a clear justification for the need for ARCC services; (b) a well-defined statement for how the proposed research is aligned with ASTRO's mission; and (c) the desired research outcome aligns with the goals of this support program.
